Designed by Brewster Bye Architects for Mayfair Developments, the project was the second phase of a three-phase development.

The first phase comprised of two 15 storey curved, stepped blocks of 404 residential apartments cleverly positioned to rise to an adjacent peak together.

The second phase is a curved 20 storey block positioned directly behind them creating a further 183 apartments.

Forterra supplied more than 240,000 Yorkshire red blend facing bricks and almost 7,500 Yorkshire red blend external radius bricks for this second phase. The bricks were chosen because they complement the local area and are produced at Forterra's nearby Howley Park factory, enhancing their sustainability credentials.
